Definitions	<p>A. Free of mental illness</p> <p>B. Psychiatric disorder that causes little functional impairment and requires infrequent psychiatric services. These services are routine in nature.</p> <p>C. Psychiatric disorder that causes some functional impairment and requires frequent psychiatric and/or psychological services. These services may be routine and /or unplanned in nature and may involve mental health monitoring.</p> <p>D. Psychiatric disorder that causes some impairment and requires frequent psychiatric and/or psychological services and/or the individual has a history of a serious suicide attempt within the past five (5) years; a history of a serious suicide attempt while in a correctional setting; or who are on involuntary medication for the treatment of a mental health condition. Services needed may be routine and/or unplanned in nature and may involve mental health monitoring.</p>

	<p>E. Psychiatric disorder that causes significant functional impairment such that the individual is unable to function in a standard prison environment and requires structured psychiatric and/or psychological services. Services needed are provided in a specialized mental health unit. There is a good prognosis for improvement in functional impairment and eventual movement to a less restricted environment.</p> <p>F. Psychiatric disorder that causes acute or chronic extreme functional impairment such that the individual is unable to function in a standard prison environment and/or causes significant risk of harm to the individual or other around the individual and requires extensive structured psychiatric and/or psychological services. Services needed are provided in a specialized mental health unit. There may be a poor prognosis for improvement in functional impairment and eventual movement to a less restricted environment.</p> <p><u>COMMENT SECTION:</u></p> <p>As the adult mental health status report form is shared with a variety of correctional staff, evaluators must strive to protect medical information of a confidential nature. Medical records are protected by the "Right of Privacy." Unauthorized release of any information or components contained in any medical records is a violation of law. The comment section will be reserved for written statements focusing on an offender's limitations in work or housing and/or anticipated dates for reclassification for offenders.</p> <p><u>SPECIAL CONDITIONS:</u></p> <p>It is the intent of the mental health status coding process to reflect existing mental health conditions. For this reason, mental health status codes are to be based on documentation in the medical packet. In the event that an offender is transferred to another institution due to a change in the mental health status code and the receiving facility does not agree with the changed code, the mental health staff of the receiving facility is to contact the transferring institution's mental health staff and discuss the reason (s). If an agreement cannot be reached then the Executive Director of Behavioral Health Services is to be contacted.</p>
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
